There were two goals in today's meeting, that is, Fall semester event planning and officer elections.

EVENT PLANNING

- "Sponsor a Family" – it was suggested that information sheets for new immigrant families on safety net clinics and dental clinics for the uninsured be made available to those that want to access this information. Linh and Giao will work on making this information sheet.
- Fundraising events – a new design for the AAMSA T-shirt is needed and will be discussed further.
- Speakers – the acupuncture speaker may be asked to speak again. Other ideas include speakers for alternative medicine and traditional practices such as the coining and cupping.

Activities planned for the Spring semester were also outlined but not heavily discussed as it was not priority as of now.

After discussing over the planned events, officer elections commenced. With the majority of attendees being committee members, Hang Pham and Lisa Guo were elected as the education chair and third M1 representative respectively.
